appointment**




**The entrance

have an appointment.




You can let the receptionist know if you would prefer to wait in the car. They will phone you when the doctor or nurse is ready.






**Otherwise, this

will be provided. They will
show you where the toilet is
located.**

The doctor or nurse will ask you some questions about how you are feeling.





If there is a particular communication aid or method you like to use, please let the doctor or nurse know.


**These are

The doctor may give you a prescription for medicine to help you if you are feeling sick. They will explain how best to take this medicine.



Before leaving, you need to stop at the reception. Here you can collect your prescription and ask if payment is required.
