This shop sells meat, vegetables and milk.



**This shop is located
on High Street in
Killarney. It is across
the road from Dealz.
There is lots of short
term on street parking
nearby.**





When you walk in the front door, there is a meat fridge to the left. You can take food out of this and bring it to the counter.

On the right hand side there is a display with jams, honey and vegetables. You can pick these up and pay at the counter.





There is also a fridge to the right. This has breakfast meats, milk and vegetables. You can take things out of this fridge and bring to the counter.



This is the counter. You can order meat from the butcher at the counter OR you can place the food you've taken from the fridges on the counter.

Here are some butchers from the shop. Denis and Kieran can take your order and tell you how much you have to pay.



The butcher might weigh your food on a scale. The scale doesn't make noise. They moved the noisy saw and mincer to the back of the shop.

If you are paying in cash, you pay at the till. If you are paying with card or phone, the butcher will direct you to the card machine.



It is ok to ask the butcher questions about the meat, recipes and cooking times. They might not know the answer but they will try and help.



Butcher Shops can be smelly. It's ok to hold your nose if the smell is disturbing you. The butcher is used to seeing people hold their nose.
